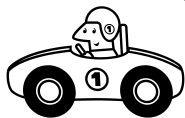




February 2009 What's going on at Masa?

Romance, Trees, Coffee? We love things that are great, including movies! The Oscars are the most fun with a group so we'll be airing them - volume off so we can talk!



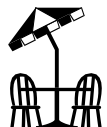
Thursday February 26 It's Go Eat LA (formerly Dine-Out LA)!
